## Méthode Cap Classique

### **Villiera Tradition Rosé Brut NV, Stellenbosch R240**

Joyful, rich pink colour; vivacious cascading bubbles and the full rich flavour of Pinot Noir combined with the elegance of Chardonnay and the uniqueness of Pinotage providing the colour

### **Simonsig Kaapse Vonkel Brut NV, Stellenbosch R250**

Elegant and refreshing with hints of green apple, apricot and cherries; flavours of baked bread with fresh acidity on the palate

### **Pierre Jourdan Brut NV, Franschhoek R265**

Chardonnay contributes elegance; Pinot Noir intensity and richness. After blending, the wine undergoes the traditional second fermentation in the bottle which yields the beautiful lively bubbles in the glass.

### **Graham Beck Brut Rosé NV, Robertson R285**

The Rosé NV was allowed enough time on the lees to develop subtle yeasty undertones and to burst with berry and cherry flavours. On the nose expect whiffs of raspberries/cherries and a few secondary aromas of minerality. The palate delivers a lively mousse but fine in the mouth.

### **Klein Optenhorst Pinot Noir Brut 2013, Wellington & Elgin R325**

Attractive salmon pink in colour; strawberry fruit, light yeasty aromas and a hint of spice on the nose

### **Silverthorn The Green Man Brut 2013, Robertson R435**

Fresh aromas of acacia blossom, green apple and freshly baked brioche; balanced with an elegant structure and a fine mousse which imparts a gentle explosion of bubbles on the palate

## French Champagne

### **Veuve Clicquot Brut NV, France R1465**

Beautiful structure, elegance and sophistication; initial notes of fruit are followed by brioche and vanilla



## Rosé & Blanc De Noir

### **Signal Gun Rosé 2015, Durbanville R135**

Aromas of strawberries and cream, red fruit and marshmallow with floral notes and a crisp, dry finish on the palate

### **Waterford Rose-Mary Rosé 2015, Stellenbosch R185**

Fresh raspberry and apricot fruit on the nose; well integrated natural acid leads to an elegantly tangy mouthfeel with a characteristic dry finish

### **Noble Hill Mourvèdre Rosé 2016, Simonsberg-Paarl R185**

This rosé stands out with a light salmon pink colour and a bit of orange peel on the rim. It elicits aromas of rose water, strawberries, watermelon and black currant and has a crisp, dry finish.

## Sauvignon Blanc

### **Usana Sauvignon Blanc 2015, Stellenbosch R160**

Lively acidity is balanced by tropical fruit characteristics. On the nose and palate there are hints of gooseberry and passion fruit, with hints of freshly cut grass.

### **Neil Ellis Groenekloof Sauvignon Blanc 2015, Darling R175**

Predominant flavours of tropical fruit with herbaceous overtones, whilst the overall impression is of elegance and delicacy with a long flavoursome finish

### **Driehoek Sauvignon Blanc 2015, Cederberg R200**

Lemongrass and passion fruit aromas with a hint of gooseberry; a creamy yet crisp finish on the palate

### **Bartinney Sauvignon Blanc 2016, Stellenbosch R200**

Granadilla, green fig and grapefruit aromas; the palate is layered with ripe tropical fruit and underlining minerality, typical of the Banghoek Valley

### **Dalla Cia Sauvignon Blanc 2016, Stellenbosch R205**

A gentle bouquet of sweet gooseberry and ripe fig with hints of minerality

### **Ataraxia Sauvignon Blanc 2016, Hemel-en-Aarde Valley R205**

Tropical and citrus fruit aromas; stylish and individual with alluring minerality

### **Tokara Reserve Collection Sauvignon Blanc 2016, Stellenbosch R250**

This lovely wine displays a beautiful pale straw colour with vibrant green on the rim. The aromas are fresh and opulent – packed with notes of guava, passion fruit, quince and hints of lemongrass and dried herbs. The flavours are reminiscent of the aromas – full, rich and textured with a lingering dry, chalky finish.

## **Chenin Blanc**

### **AA Badenhorst Secateurs Chenin Blanc 2016, Swartland R140**

The aromas are flinty with honey, orange blossom and white stone fruit notes.

### **Cederberg Chenin Blanc 2016, Cederberg R170**

Layers of grapefruit, melon and fleshy white pear; mouth-coating creaminess with lively crisp acidity

### **Raats Original Chenin Blanc 2016, Stellenbosch R180**

Distinctive yellow apple and pineapple core, alongside notes of green melon and limes; finishes with zesty citrus flavours and has a long mineral finish

## **Chardonnay**

### **Warwick The First Lady Unoaked Chardonnay 2015, Stellenbosch R175**

Intense nose of fresh pineapple, lemon, citrus and floral notes; the mid-palate is broad and appealing, supported by a lingering acidity

### **Le Riche Chardonnay 2015, Stellenbosch R250**

Crisp lemony freshness, balanced by lively acidity and firm structure on the palate

### **Bouchard Finlayson Sans Barrique Chardonnay 2015, Hemel-en-Aarde Valley R260**

Flinty and dry with strong hints of kiwi and green apple; mineral-rich with excellent purity of fruits and long natural acid balance

### **Jordan Barrel Fermented Chardonnay 2015, Stellenbosch R285**

Bold and graceful with fragrances of lemon biscuit and overripe oranges

### **Waterford Estate Chardonnay 2014, Stellenbosch R340**

Aromatics of citrus blossoms and lime cordial with soft roasted almond undertones from subtle oak usage

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**Waterford Estate Single Vineyard Chardonnay 2014, Stellenbosch R390**

A brilliant yellow colour with a green hue is very characteristic of this single vineyard Chardonnay. Aromatics of peach pip and lemon zest, as well as soft coconut husk and nutmeg notes from the gentle oak usage; a slightly fuller Chardonnay due to an overall warmer season

## White Blends

**Reyneke Organic Sauvignon Blanc/Sémillon 2016, Stellenbosch R140**

Gooseberry and lemon peel fruitiness on the nose leads to a fresh lily flower fragrance. The palate is fresh with delicate yet zesty acidity and taught linear structure.

**Thelema Sutherland Viognier/Roussanne 2014, Elgin R225**

Aromas of sun ripened apricots, peaches and a hint of spring blossoms; summer fruit flavour and good acidity are complemented by excellent texture

**Keermont Terrasse Chenin Blanc/Sauvignon Blanc/Chardonnay/Viognier 2014, Stellenbosch R295**

Citrus blossom, hazelnut and butterscotch on the nose with layers of ripe citrus and stone fruit flavours that evolve into a lingering dry earthy finish

**De Morgenzon Maestro Roussanne/Chardonnay/Grenache Blanc/Chenin Blanc/Viognier 2014, Stellenbosch R320**

Orange and yellow stone fruits, with a hint of spice, citrus and blossoms; full-bodied, textured and nuanced with a lingering aftertaste

## Other Interesting White Varietals

**Usana Pinot Gris 2015, Stellenbosch R160**

Crisp and refreshing, displaying hints of green apple, pear, sweet honeydew melon and a fresh, flinty edge; a smooth, subtle overtone leaves a distinctive impression on the palate

**Jordan The Real McCoy Riesling 2015, Stellenbosch R215**

Perfect balance between sugar and acidity that refreshes the palate; intense flavours of lime through to white peach and apple

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**Kleynood Tamboerskloof Viognier 2016, Stellenbosch R215**

Candy apple, rose petal, delicate jasmine and a slight vanilla blossom aroma, supported by fresh apple and white peach on the palate

## Pinot Noir

**Thelema Sutherland Pinot Noir 2013, Elgin R225**

Pure strawberry fruit aromas and perfumed forest floor characters with hints of smoky spice; bright berry fruit and spice on the palate with a long, refined finish

**Newton Johnson Walker Bay Pinot Noir 2014, Hemel-en-Aarde Valley R365**

Aromas of cherry, raspberry and spice; succulent with a juicy finish and playful tannins

**Crystallum Peter Max Pinot Noir 2015, Hemel-en-Aarde Valley R415**

Elegant and perfumed; the nose is floral and fragrant, with strawberry tea and sweet spice dominant

**Paul Cluver Estate Pinot Noir 2014, Grabouw R460**

This wine has a lovely luminosity – the colour is bright plum skin. The nose has delicate, earthy almond aromas combined with cranberry, pomegranate and raspberries. On the palate these characteristics follow through combining with interesting seaweed/umami savoury flavours.

## Merlot

**Sterhuis Merlot 2013, Stellenbosch R275**

Flavours of fresh plums, mulberries, spicy fruitcake, chocolate and coffee on the nose; integrated oak flavours and a velvet soft tannin finish

**Thelema Merlot 2013, Stellenbosch R275**

Juicy red fruit and concentrated flavours with balanced tannin structure; hints of dark chocolate on the finish complete this wonderfully balanced wine

**Eagles' Nest Merlot 2012, Constantia R325**

Aromas reflect an array of gorgeous red berry fruit, complemented by nuances of savoury spice and crushed pepper; complex and focused with bright acidity and balanced tannins

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**Rust en Vrede Merlot 2014, Stellenbosch R460**

Aromas of potpourri and dried flowers with notes of cedar and subtle oak; palate is well-balanced and juicy with savoury notes

## Cabernet Sauvignon

**Warwick The First Lady Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Stellenbosch R170**

The bouquet reveals red berry, blackcurrant and pleasant herbal characters. The smooth, ripe, round tannins make this wine easy to drink while still retaining good structure.

**Usana The Fox Cabernet Sauvignon 2014, Stellenbosch R180**

A medium to full-bodied wine with soft tannins; rich, ruby-coloured; soft on the palate and displays typical hints of dark berries, spice, cigar box and a touch of vanilla; a beautifully balanced wine

**Springfield Whole Berry Cabernet Sauvignon 2014, Robertson R270**

Full of juicy dark berry fruit with velvet soft tannins and classic varietal characteristics

**Stark-Condé Cabernet Sauvignon 2014, Stellenbosch R320**

Bright red fruits with excellent acidity and good balance between power and elegance

**Le Riche Cabernet Sauvignon 2013, Stellenbosch R455**

Spicy oak and ripe cherry flavours are balanced by soft, elegant tannins with a firm structure and a lingering, succulent aftertaste.

## Shiraz

**Neil Ellis Groenekloof Shiraz 2014, Darling R220**

Pure blackberry fruit with underlying white pepper, liquorice aromas and hints of violets; elegant but concentrated palate with underlying cedar spice and a finely balanced tannin structure

**Raka Biography Shiraz 2012, Walker Bay R260**

Spicy aromas with hints of chocolate, coffee and black fruits on the bouquet which follow through on a silky, full body palate, with dried plum and pepper flavours; complete structure of a full-bodied wine; well-balanced between tannins and acidity

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**Kleynood Tamboerskloof Shiraz 2013, Stellenbosch R305**

The nose is rich with red berries, black pepper and cloves; a balanced palate confirms the nose with prominent flavours of strawberry, red cherry and cocoa

**Stark-Condé Shiraz 2014, Stellenbosch R320**

Aromas of berry fruit, pepper and subtle dark chocolate; fruity and well-balanced with the beautiful varietal characteristics of spice and mocha bean

**Keermont Shiraz 2013, Stellenbosch R380**

Aromas of red spices, herbs and lavender; the palate offers flavours of red fruit, anise and a mineral saltiness with a succulent dry finish

## Pinotage

**Raka Pinotage 2014, Walker Bay R175**

Dark colour and typical Pinotage nose of banana and rooibos tea; full-bodied; displays spice and pepper on the palate; soft and smooth with a lingering finish

**Villiera Pinotage 2013, Stellenbosch R195**

This is a new style of Pinotage with subtle oak, spice, plums, vanilla and a slight smokiness on the nose. On the palate it is soft but well-structured, with good length. The wine is well-balanced.

**Beaumont Pinotage 2014, Bot River R285**

Cool climate Pinotage with fresh red berry fruit; medium-bodied with well integrated tannins

**Vriesenhof Pinotage 2013, Stellenbosch R375**

Heady aromas of black cherries and chocolate with hints of spice; palate shows beautiful sour cherries and raspberries with a slight savoury note

## Red Blends

**AA Badenhorst Secateurs Cinsault/Shiraz/Grenache/Mourvèdre/Pinotage 2014, Swartland R175**

Aromas are perfumed, peppery, spicy, smoky and exhibit ripe red fruit notes. Palate texture is subtle and smooth on entry with enough grip to end dry and refreshing.

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**Raka Quinary Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot/Cabernet Franc/Petit Verdot/Malbec  
2013, Walker Bay R220**

A rich, full-bodied blend with aromas of fruit and flavours of cassis, blackberry and dark cherry; on the palate the same fruit tones are complemented by spice and well-integrated oak; complex with fine tannins; dark plum colour

**Newton Johnson Full Stop Rock Syrah/Grenache/Mourvèdre 2014, Hemel-en-Aarde  
Valley R245**

Succulent plum blossom with slight cloves and anise on the nose; lots of texture on the palate with red and dark berry fruit, finishing with a subtle mocha bean dryness

**Luddite Saboteur Shiraz/Cabernet Sauvignon/Mourvèdre 2014, Bot River R375**

Liquorice, cinnamon, plum and violets on the nose with dark fruit and spice on the palate; rich with opulent fruit and balanced tannins

**Miles Mossop Max Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot/Petit Verdot 2013, Stellenbosch  
R530**

Aromas of ripe red and black berries, punctuated by smoked meats and crème de cassis; palate is full, rich and complex, balanced by the sweet fruit and dry tannins

**Bartinney Élevage Cabernet Sauvignon/Petit Verdot/Merlot/Malbec 2010,  
Stellenbosch R550**

This wine has a brilliant, deep ruby colour, a complex nose of black cherries, violets, mocha, with a hint of classic French oak. The palate is long with blackberry fruit over a backbone of silky tannins.

**Tokara Director's Reserve Red 2012, Stellenbosch R650**

The nose is shy at first, but then opens up to a melange of red and black fruits with hints of dried herbs, eucalyptus, cedar wood and graphite. The flavours are those of dark cherries, raspberries and blackcurrant.

**De Toren Z Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon/Cabernet Franc/Petit Verdot/Malbec 2013,  
Stellenbosch R695**

Aromas of dark and red cherries with subtle vanilla, fresh herbs and clove spice; ripe berry fruit on the palate with a dense rich finish

**De Toren Fusion V Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot/Cabernet Franc/Petit Verdot/Malbec  
2013, Stellenbosch R885**

Ripe berry fruit with hints of dark chocolate, leather and cedar on the nose; the palate is elegant, balanced and complex

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## Other Interesting Red Varietals

### **Raats Dolomite Cabernet Franc 2014, Stellenbosch R225**

Dark berries, spiciness and herbs linger on the palate. The wine has great purity of fruit with a hint of wet-stone minerality and a velvet soft finish.

### **Radford Dale Thirst Gamay Noir 2015, Stellenbosch R225**

This rare Gamay Noir is lean and light but by no means simple. The palate displays supple tannins that provide texture, expressive red fruits, herbaceous tomato-leaf and a fantastic length.

### **Beaumont Mourvèdre 2015, Bot River R390**

Delicious blackberry fruit with spice from small percentage of Shiraz; complex with nice length

### **Tokara Grenache 2012, Stellenbosch R590**

The nose has beautiful perfumed floral notes with hints of geranium and rose petals. There is abundant red berry fruit reminiscent of fruit pastilles with an underlying "garrigue" herbal note.

## Fortified Wine

### **Mullineux Straw Wine, Swartland R250**

Deep golden straw in colour, with a rich, viscous appearance; the nose and palate is a complex, enticing blend of dried peaches, apricots and marmalade with savoury, nutty aromas of almonds, marzipan and honey

### **Tokara Noble Late Harvest 2014, Stellenbosch R690**

The wine has a brilliant rich golden hue with a hint of green. The aromas are rich and complex with notes of dried apricot and peach.
